

IMPACT ON THE GAMING INDUSTRY

Blurring the lines between Land-based and Internet gaming technology!

- Gaming is moving to a personal device anywhere anytime
 - EGM's always online, contain tablets or cell phones and using personal online wallets
- Gaming is shifting from game centric to system centric to player centric

MOBILE GAMING MARKET

- The massive growth of smart phones and tablets is one of the most important technology innovations in the online gaming industry in the last 5 years
 - By the end of 2014 there will be more than 1.75 Billion number of smartphones in use
 - By the end of 2014 there are more than 7.5 Billion mobile subscribers
 - Analysts predict an annual growth as high as 39%
- Dec 2012: 28 year Londoner won \$530,584 at William Hill property playing a game on his phone!



IMPACT ON POLICY DOMAIN -CHALLENGES

- Increased pressure to create policies and technical standards
- Insufficient capacity for effective oversight
- Technology is changing at an exponential rate
- Resource restrictions: Time, Money and Expertise
- How to effectively and efficiently supervise and control

IMPACT OF TECHNOLOGY CHANGE FOR REGULATORS

 Regulators are challenged with crafting regulations on how to supervise and control this borderless and faceless new industrial



- Regulators have to adapt from chasing a paper trail to active realtime monitoring
 - Lack of standards forces custom interfaces for every system licensed
- Rapidly fading technology distinction between land based and online
 - No longer land-based & internet gaming but online gaming
 - Multiple personal electronic wallets Paypal, ApplePay...
- Playing a Catch-up game chasing the internet
